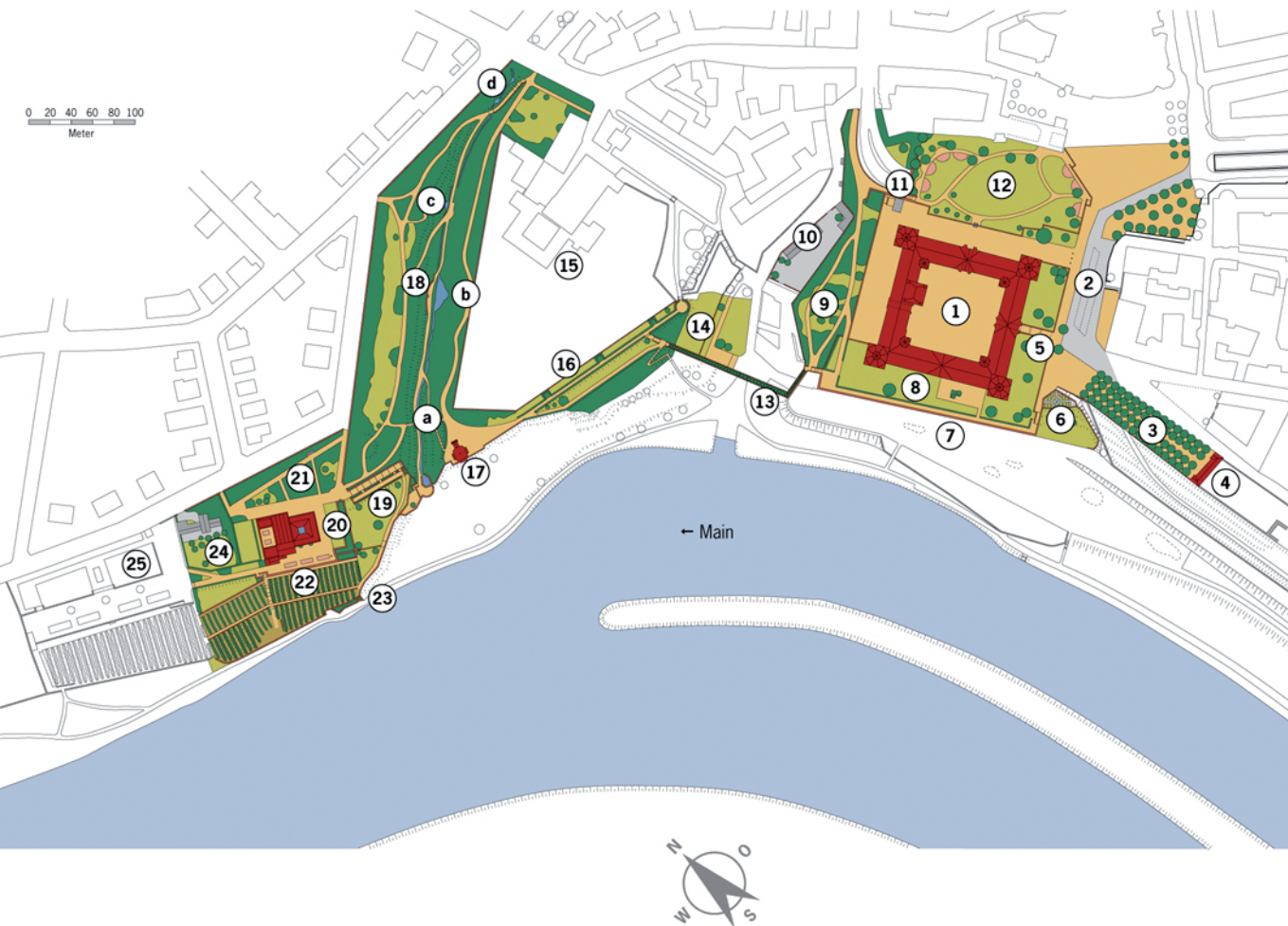


Plan

Johannisburg Palace, the Pompeiianum and the surrounding gardens



- 1 Johannisburg Palace (Ridinger, 1605-1614)
- 2 Palace Square
- 3 Chestnut wood
- 4 Columned hall (so-called Kornhäuschen, 1805)
- 5 Palace moat (so-called Rehgärtchen) with bridge to the main portal
- 6 Palace garden gate (reconstructed in 1962), below the small herb garden (1994)
- 7 Armorial wall (1607)
- 8 South-west palace garden on the River Main terrace
- 9 North-west palace garden (so-called Eiskellergarten)
- 10 Maintenance yard
- 11 Gate to the northern bastion (reconstructed in 1984), letterbox embrasure to one side
- 12 New garden (1993, over the underpass of 1984)
- 13 Part of the old town wall with the Theoderich Gate (mid-15th century), on top of it a pergola (so-called Kapuzinergang; Herigoyen, 1788)
- 14 Bastion on the Karlsberg with a view of the Capuchin Monastery
- 15 Capuchin Monastery
- 16 Hedge walk
- 17 Salon (so-called Frühstückstempel; Herigoyen, 1782)
- 18 Former town moat (converted into a garden in 1785 as part of the 'offenes Schöntal', a garden connecting the palace gardens with Schönbusch Park, redesigned in 1952)
- 18a Iron footbridge over the valley with a stream
- 18b Pond
- 18c Viewing platform
- 18d Small cascade
- 19 Pergola (1961)
- 20 Pompeiianum (v. Gärtner, 1840-1848)
- 21 Pine grove
- 22 Vineyard (laid out in 1848, replanted 1951)
- 23 Pompeiianum cliff
- 24 Former administrator's house
- 25 Municipal Pompeiianum Garden (1964)
